Exchange your Vows in a small intimate setting...

Sohier Park is a public park and there is no fee to use the facility. Large weddings are not allowed however it is a wonderful venue to exchange your vows in a small, intimate ceremony. The park is extremely busy year-round and you may not reserve or block off any parking spaces or areas of the park. In addition, there may be other weddings or events going on at the same time. Parking is limited and it is suggested that you make arrangements for transportation. We also please ask that you adhere to the following policies:

- No set up of any kind is allowed
- Tents and canopies are not permitted
- Chairs may be used for elderly and handicapped only
- Confetti and rice are not allowed
- Amplified music is not permitted
- Please obey all park rules and ordinances
